Providing Novel Project Ideas and Motivation to students to effectively use the lockdown period

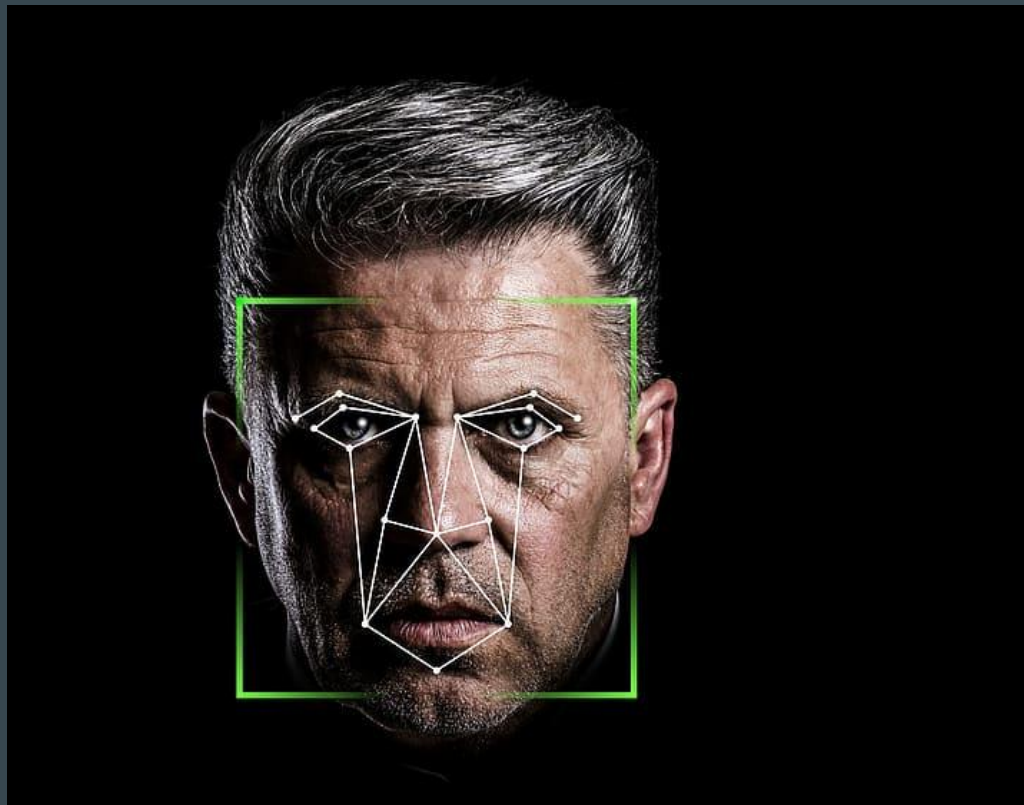
Objective:

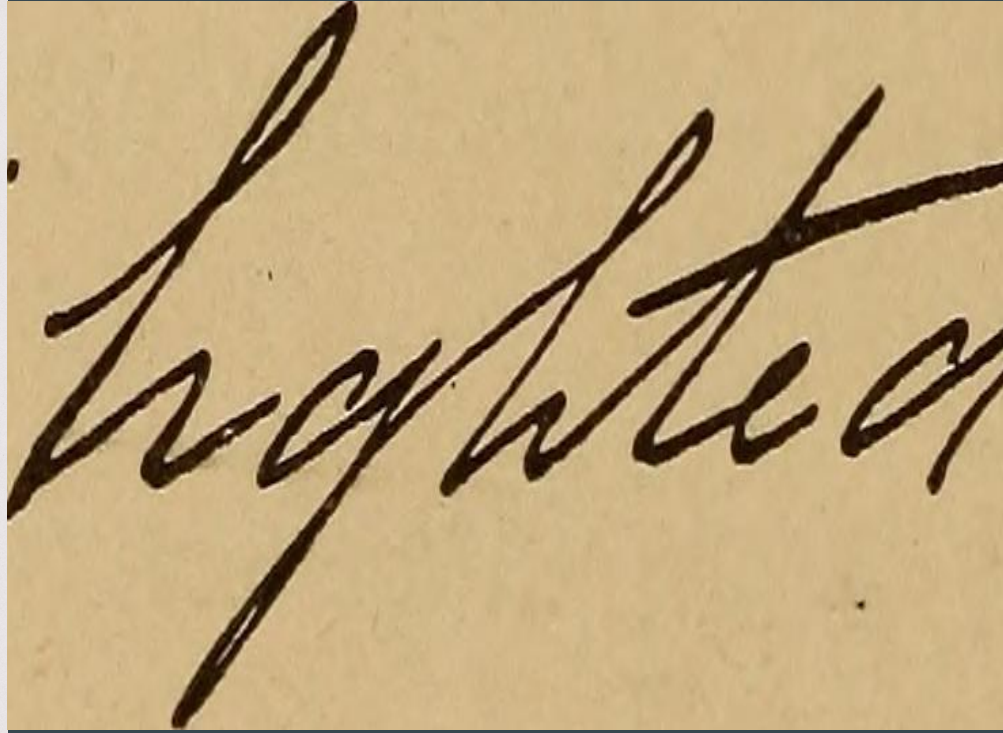

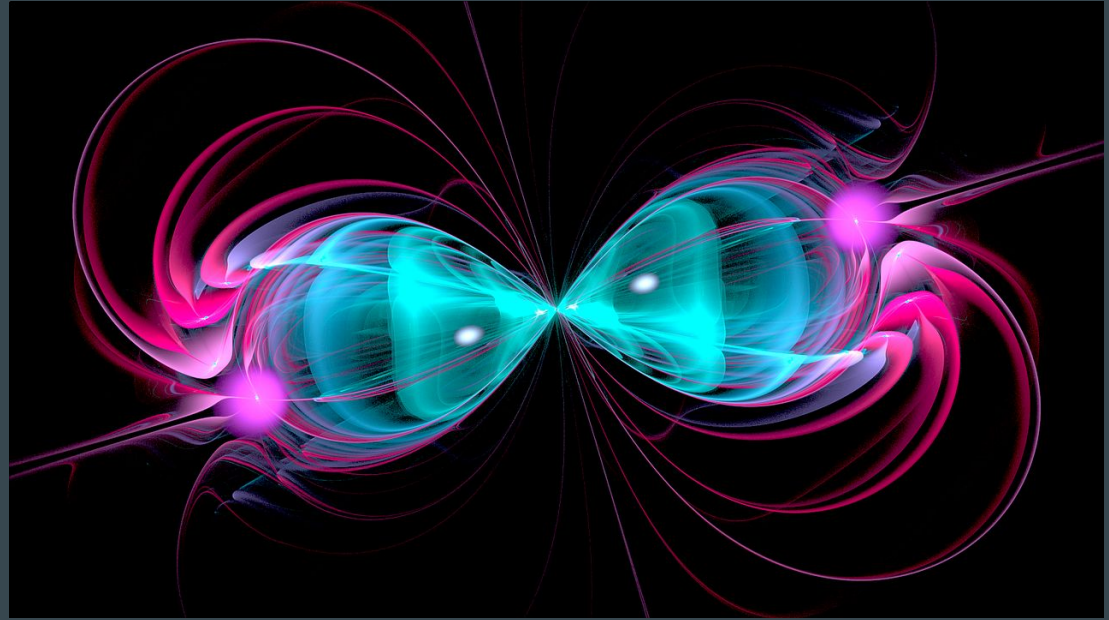
